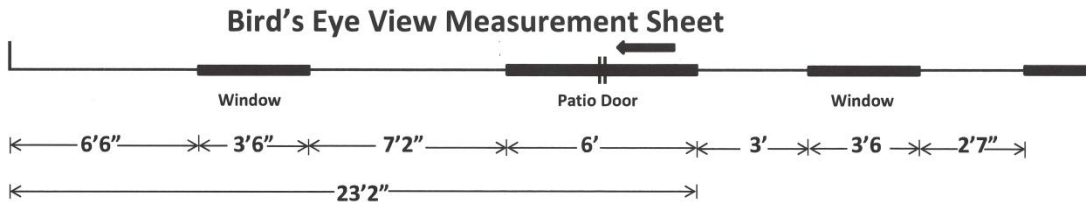


How to measure for a new deck

When no current deck exists



Measurements Requested:

- Width of house in area pertaining to the deck
- Location and measurements of doors and windows in the same area
- Distance from the bottom of exterior doors to the ground
- Estimated slope of ground away from house (in inches per ft., best guess is fine)
- Location and size of any permanent items on home or yard
 - Utilities – Gas Meter, AC Unit, Faucets etc.
 - Patio, retaining walls, stair landings and sidewalks
 - Trees or permanent flower beds
 - Hot tubs, Pools etc.

Photos Requested:

- Large shot of entire back of house
- Straight on shot of wall looking at the deck area
- Angled shot of left side of yard looking at deck area
- Angled shot of right side of yard looking at deck area
- Any other shot you might deem important to us (the more the better)

Most Important! – Keep this simple

We do not expect you to hire a surveyor to prepare a drawing. Do the best you can with what you have. We employ professional designers that are experienced in scaling photos to estimate measurements.

We will always **confirm measurements on site** prior to beginning construction.

Good photos are the biggest help. If you are taking digital pictures you **do not** need to print them out. Bring the camera or phone you used and we will handle it from there.
